Do Kids Need Parents' Permission to Sign Out Items?

No. We do not prevent anyone from borrowing any items they wish, and this includes children. For more information, read SPL's Statement on Intellectual Freedom.

In order to get a Library card, children under 14 years of age must have a parent or guardian sign their member application. Parents and guardians are the best judges of what kids should and should not do. We encourage you to have discussions with your children about what is appropriate for them to read, listen, view and play.
