## Bilingual Family Storytime at Saskatoon Public Library

### **Bilingual Family Storytime**

Bilingual Family Storytime is a monthly program for children under 10 and their caregivers, featuring a guest storyteller who presents stories or songs in a language other than English.

A library employee introduces the guest, and the program is delivered half in English by the library employee and half in another language by the guest. The program is 30 minutes long.

Guests fill out an application form on Saskatoon Public Library's website (<https://saskatoonlibrary.ca/about/partnerships/bilingual-family-storytime/>) to apply to be a guest storyteller.

Guest Storytellers will:

- Arrive at the library 30 minutes early and introduce themselves to the library employee running the program.
- Stay for the whole program.
- Present 15 minutes of stories appropriate for children under 10 years of age. Stories could include reading books, presenting a told story, or a song in your language.
