## Position Overview

The Senior Manager, Programming & Creative Spaces is an integral member of the management team who is directly responsible for leading targeted services and programs, and the use of library public spaces. This includes both digital spaces and physical spaces at all Saskatoon Public Library (SPL) locations, including but not limited to the Local History Room, Gaming Rooms, The Gallery, Innovation Labs, children’s story rooms and the theatre at the central library.

The Senior Manager, Programming & Creative Spaces leads programming for all SPL locations, including SPL-developed and partnered programs. This individual is responsible for assessing programming, recommending improvements and implementing approved changes.

As a member of the management team, the Senior Manager, Programming & Creative Spaces provides system-wide leadership, acting as a change agent who fosters innovation. They will be expected to bring forward and implement new ideas and processes, as well as support employee success. This individual provides accurate and efficient communication to implement strategic priorities and does so in a consistent and coordinated manner. They will be responsible for supporting the needs of our community in alignment with SPL’s Community-Inspired Service Model and Strategic Plan.

The Senior Manager, Programming & Creative Spaces acts as an advisor to the Director, Public Services, and may be required to assume temporary operational responsibility for Public Services areas in the absence of the Director, Public Services.
