Saskatoon Public Library Introduces New Community Access Card

SASKATOON – The Saskatoon Public Library today announced the addition of a new Community Access Card for Saskatoon citizens who may not have a permanent home address.

The new Community Access Card enables citizens without a fixed address to take advantage of the library's resources and services. This includes opportunities to borrow print and electronic books, movies and music; browse magazines and newspapers; and, access the library's computers and Internet. Up to four items may be borrowed at a time.

An individual can acquire a Community Access Card without identification or fixed home address if someone can vouch for his or her identity, like a shelter worker or religious leader.

Saskatoon Public Library employees will be on location at The Lighthouse and Saskatoon Food Bank to promote the new Card:

Monday, November 2 – Saskatoon Food Bank

The new Community Card is being introduced as part of Saskatoon Public Library's Fall Membership Drive.
