Submission guidelines:

Submit your entry by **Thursday, April 30, 2020**, in one of the following categories:

Poetry: up to four pages of poetry in any style and on any theme

Short Story: one story up to eight pages on any theme

Reminiscence: up to eight pages on any theme

Other: up to eight pages in another style on any topic

- You may only submit writing that you have not submitted to us in a previous year.
- Put your name on each entry, as well as the title of the work and the category of writing (poem, short story, reminiscence, other).
- Writers retain copyright over their own writing, but entries will not be returned.
- Print entries must be typed and double-spaced.
- You may enter as many times as you want in as many categories as you want.
- Print entries must be submitted in a sealed envelope, along with a completed registration form (the reverse side of this page) that must include the title of each entry (up to three titles on each registration form).
